

Request for Bids: Hay to be put up on shares 2021

Rosebud Economic Development Corporation (REDCO) is accepting bids for haying to be done on a share agreement for summer 2021 on one parcel at Mustang Meadows (Wolakota Buffalo Range), in the southwest corner of Todd County. Indian Preference applies; REDCO reserves the right to reject or accept any bids.

Redbird Flats: consists of approximately 460 acres of grass on the east side of Mustang Meadows. An estimated 420 acres are hayable, with no guarantee of actual acreage. This parcel is accessed through St. Francis, SD.

Terms of haying include:

- 1. Haying must start between July 1 and July 31
- 2. Lessee (bidder) will be responsible for stacking REDCO's share of hay on site at sites specified by Wolakota Manager
- 3. Lessee will be responsible for all operational costs of haying including machinery, fuel, labor, and supplies
- 4. Hay must be put up in large round bales with net wrap
- Communicating timeline and bale counts with Wolakota Manager prior to removal of any hay
- 6. No subleasing or subcontracting without prior approval of Wolakota manager
- 7. Lessee's share of hay must be removed by December 31, 2021, unless otherwise approved
- 8. Does not include any grazing, farming or other use privileges.

Bids must include:

- Percentage of hay crop to lessee (bidder) and to lessor (REDCO)
- Tribal enrollment number and documentation if claiming Indian Preference.
